Braya exports first biofuel product

On March 27th, Braya made its inaugural shipment of biofuel, crafted from soya bean oil, from Newfoundland and Labrador to California. This renewable diesel is a game-changer for the trucking industry, slashing emissions by half. Plans are already in motion to expand into aviation fuels. With a production capacity of up to 18,000 barrels per day (bpd), the aim is to ramp up to 24,000 bpd within the next couple of years. Although California remains the primary market for renewable diesel, the government is exploring options to introduce local sales in the future
