If development proceeds as expected, increased activity at Bull Arm could create opportunities for businesses involved in:

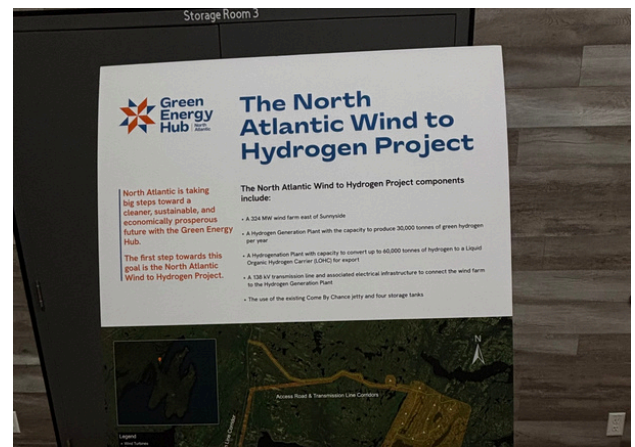
- logistics and transportation
